You have relatives who live within a two hour drive, they live in the hills so they will not have lost their home. The eldest child has exams in the few weeks, all the school work was destroyed. The father is a keen fisherman and his fishing rod was lost and this was a family heirloom.

**FAMILY HAITI**  
**CITIZEN CREDITS: 800**

You are a family of five and your house has been completely destroyed by the earthquake. Your whole family work in the local market but this has been completely destroyed as well. It is your middle child's birthday in two days. You live very close to extended family but you have been unable to make contact with them since the earthquake. The mother was badly hurt from falling debris.

**FAMILY USA**

You are a family of six and your home was destroyed in the recent Hurricane Katrina. One of the victims of the hurricane was the family dog. The youngest child is finding the loss of the family pet incredibly hard to bear. You are a single income family due to the poor health of the father.
